Reading

Please continue to read regularly with your child. This can be book, magazine or online material. Please question your child about what they are reading to ensure that they are understanding it.

<u>Maths</u>

Times Tables Rockstars – your child's login is included. This will help them learn and increase their knowledge of the times tables.

Purple Mash

Your child has a login for Purple Mash. Purple Mash has activities for all subjects and year groups. They will receive a password for the site in paper form as a reminder.

Times Table Rockstars

Your child will also come home weith a login for Times Table Rockstars. Regular times table practice is essential.
