Masks and Face Coverings

Thank you so much to everyone who has been wearing face coverings on the yard. Whilst they are uncomfortable, they do help to stop the spread of Coronavirus and keep people safe. We would also request that only one adult drops off/collects a child from school to reduce congestion on the yard and also request that people socially distance when on the premises.

Bubble Closures

Like most schools, we have now had to close a 'bubble' in school. All schools are doing what they can, but we are working in difficult circumstances. Closing a bubble is not ideal and will be a last resort. However, just to inform you of the process, the following events take place. Firstly, if a child/staff member tests positive, school are informed. Following this, the school will ring the Department of Education/Public Health and Sefton Council to inform them. We are then asked several questions and from the information we give, we are told what steps to take and we will inform you of these asap. There has been lots of disruption to all schools and we, as much as you, are praying for some stability!

We understand that things are difficult now, but ask that if your child is able to, they attend school on time each day. Please ensure that they have everything that they need as we are still having people asking the office staff to pass on messages or items.
