Masks and Face Coverings Reminder

Thank you so much to everyone who has been wearing face coverings on the yard. Whilst they are uncomfortable, they do help to stop the spread of Coronavirus and keep people safe. We ask those who are able to wear a mask do so. We would also request that only one adult drops off/collects a child from school to reduce congestion on the yard and also request that people socially distance when on the premises.

Attendance and Punctuality

We understand that things are difficult now, but ask that if your child is able to, they attend school on time each day. Please ensure that they have everything that they need as we are still having people asking the office staff to pass on messages or items. If you or your child has any symptoms of Coronavirus, the children must not come to school until a negative test has been confirmed. If a person has contact with someone who has tested positive, **THEY MUST ISOLATE FOR 14 DAYS-** this applies even if the person who has had contact tests negative.
