Dear Parent/Carer

The Government have said that the earliest possible date for schools to return is Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March and we will find out on this date if this is to happen. Until then, please keep logging on each day to complete your tasks, or alternatively come to school to pick up a work pack for your child. If these are taken, we will monitor use so that if they are not being used to access work, we will recall them and pass them on to other children, so therefore please ensure that they are not taken if they are not needed.

The school will close for the next week and the teachers will have a well-earned break. Some staff have been in school teaching whilst their year group colleagues have been preparing online resources and work packs. This has all been done whilst they, like you, have juggled their own family commitments and I would like to thank all staff for this. You should also have received regular phone calls to check in with you and ensure that things are going as well as can be. The staff were asked to complete a short video for their classes which have been posted on Twitter. If you have not seen these, go to the website and look on the class pages. There you will see the Twitter feed and the videos can be viewed here. More of these will follow so keep checking!

Government Free school meal vouchers have been issued to cover the period up to the end of this week. However, Sefton council have told us that they themselves are providing vouchers for the coming week, so you will receive a WONDE text message in order to access this. These will be sent out today and if you have any difficulty accessing it, please contact school asap.

As I said, next week is half term and for many of you, it will be no different as you have not been attending school for some time.
