Please remember that if your child has PE, they are able to come into school on that day in their kits. Also, can we please ask that children stick to a regular meal pattern so if they are on packed lunch, they stay on this and not regularly change, as this makes ordering school meal supplies difficult for the cook.

Importantly, Y6 have been allocated their new Secondary schools and it seems strange that they will be leaving us in July after two very difficult years. We have also been given a list of children who will be joining us in Reception in September and we are now working through the list making contact with parents/carers ready to welcome them.

The lockdown was a difficult experience and it has seen many organisations pull together to support our community. I would like to thank every group or individual who has reached out to offer their support- it is much appreciated. Moving forward, many children will be anxious about coming back to school and may find it daunting to return.
