Dear Parents/Carers

Traffic Congestion at Start and End of Day

I am writing with another plea asking parents/carers to park away from the school when dropping off/collecting children. Parking around the school has always been an issue and you will have seen Traffic Wardens on patrol around the school, at our request. Yesterday, a child was almost seriously injured in an accident outside of the school. This is something that we **MUST** avoid. Please **DO NOT** park on yellow lines or zig-zags, as the roads are too congested and with many cars outside of the gates, it makes it extremely difficult for pedestrians and safe drivers to navigate the area.

COVID Update

You will note from the press that cases are creeping up. Although we have less cases than many schools, we are still seeing isolated incidents in various classes. Please remember the rules regarding attendance at school.

- If you have symptoms- stay at home and get a PCR test
- If you are a contact of a positive case and you are under 18 or double vaccinated, you are advised to get a PCR test. You are able to attend school whilst awaiting the result as long as you have no symptoms
- If you are a contact of a positive case and you have symptoms, you must get a PCR test and await a negative result before attending school

Secondary School Applications

Please can Y6 parents/carers ensure that they remember to apply for their child's secondary school place by the deadline of 31st October 2021. You are strongly advised to give three choices of school, in order of preference. If you only put one choice and are not successful, Sefton will allocate you another school you may wish your child to attend.

Please remember that Y6 children are attending Savio tomorrow (24/9/21) for an experience of life in Secondary School. Parents should drop their children at Savio and collect them.
