

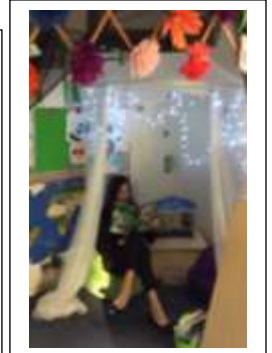
# Book Week (27<sup>th</sup> Feb – 3rd March)



This year our book week theme is- Alice In Wonderland, written by Lewis Carroll. We will be reading extracts from this book and completing dance workshops throughout the week. On World Book Day we're going to host our very own Mad Hatter's Tea Party.

World Book Day- Thursday 2nd March- As our theme is Alice In Wonderland, children and staff can come to school dressed up as any of the characters or objects linked to this classic tale: Alice, white rabbit, Queen of Hearts, King of Hearts, Cheshire Cat, Duchess, Caterpillar, Turtle, Mouse, Mad Hatter. Please don't go to any expense.

This year's Book Week Photograph Competition is: Reading In Wonderland. When Alice jumps down the rabbit hole she finds herself in a very strange land, so to take part in the competition, find an unusual place to share a book and take a photograph. Send it into school with your child's name and class on the back. All entries to be in by Friday March 3rd. Most unusual setting will win a prize.



If you have any unwanted children's books at home in good condition please send them into school. We will host a preloved book fair on World Book Day (Thursday 2nd March) selling these books for 10p. All money will go towards buying brand new books for our library.

Your child will receive a £ 1 book token, provided by the World Book Day Charity. This token can be exchanged for any of the free World Book Day books, or it can be used to get £1 off any full priced book up until Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> March.
