### Reception Open Day

### After School Club

We are please to announce that Fun4Kids have confirmed that they will be able to start an after school club for us which should commence in January 2025. This is something that we have been hoping to provide for parents for some time and we are glad that there is now enough demand to make this viable for a company to run it on our site. Please circulate the news that we will be operating from January so that any interested parents who need a school that provides after school care can enrol in school and use this service. We also continue to operate our Breakfast Club every morning.

### Reception Outdoor Area

The one area of the school that used to annoy me when showing parents around was the Reception outdoor area, as it was built on rubble from when the Infants and Juniors joined several years ago. This made it very difficult for grass to grow in the summer and in the winter it got extremely muddy. However, over £100,000 has been invested into the area to give it an AstroTurf covering, with state of the art play facilities. This is an area that we are now really proud of and we are looking forward to opening and allowing the children to use it.

Well done to our football teams who have been performing really well. Our girls have recently beaten Litherland Moss 3-0. Also, our boys have beaten St William of York 6-1 and then narrowly lost 2-1 to Springwell in a close game in the cup. Finally, our Y5 children came runners up in the Sefton Football tournament.
