School Drop Off

Please can we ask that when children are being dropped at school or Breakfast Club, that cars **DO NOT PARK** on the yellow lines or zig-zags. This presents a danger to children and adults as the area becomes very congested and it has been made worse recently by the bad weather which can cause people to slip into a congested road. Please park safely to ensure the safety of all members of our school community.

Uniform

Please can you ensure that children are sent in wearing the correct uniform for that day. Please only wear trainers and jogging bottoms if it is a PE day. Can we also ask again that all items of clothing, including hats, scarves etc are labelled so that they can be returned if they are lost. We have also noticed that some children are wearing make-up in school which is not allowed. Please can you ensure that no make-up or nail varnish is worn and please be aware that only studded earrings are allowed for safety.
