

To Know You More Clearly

Nursery, Reception and Years 1-3 are now taking part in Religion lessons using the new programme of study, To Know You More Clearly, as set out in the Religious Education Directory for Catholic Schools, Academies and Colleges in England and Wales. Years 4-6 will start the programme in the near future.

The six-branch structure



Each half-term will focus on a different branch, the themes of these are;

Creation and Covenant

Prophecy and Promise

Galilee to Jerusalem

N – The focus of this branch is for pupils to develop a developing understanding of Jesus.

R – The focus of this branch is for pupils to develop a developing understanding of Jesus.

Y1 – The overarching theme 1 is **revelation** - how do people know about God? How is God revealed to people?

Y2 – Pupils will also begin to think about good and bad choices (sin) and why the Sacrament of Reconciliation is needed.

Y3 – In this branch, pupils will encounter the Gospel of St Matthew. Matthew's gospel is divided into seven books. The first contains the birth and infancy narratives, the last describes Jesus' passion, death, and resurrection, and the five books in between give an account of the life and ministry of Jesus.
